China is one of the fastest growing markets for U.S. service exports and now ranks among the top ten destinations for U.S. service exports. In 2007, the U.S. sold over \$14 billion in services to China. China also continues to grow in importance as a market for U.S. exports via Virginia, surpassing the United Kingdom to become Virginia's second largest export destination. In 2010, Virginia exported over \$1.2 billion in goods to China, including electrical machinery, plastics, manmade staple fibers, organic chemicals, non-electrical machinery and paper and paperboard.
