Turkey's eighth largest trading partner is Virginia. Virginia exports to Turkey in 2022 were valued at \$436.9 million. In 2022, Turkey was the United States' tenth largest export market in Europe, with nearly \$15.2 billion in exports. Although Turkey is not a European Union member, Turkey has adopted many European business regulations and standards which have made it easier when it comes to selling products and conducting business in Turkey. The top categories of U.S. exports to Turkey include aircraft, mineral fuels, iron and steel, machinery, optical and medical instruments. The civilian aerospace sector has seen significant growth over the last 15 years. Despite U.S. exports making up only about five percent of Turkey's total imports, U.S. brands still enjoy widespread favorability and recognition among Turkish consumers.
